

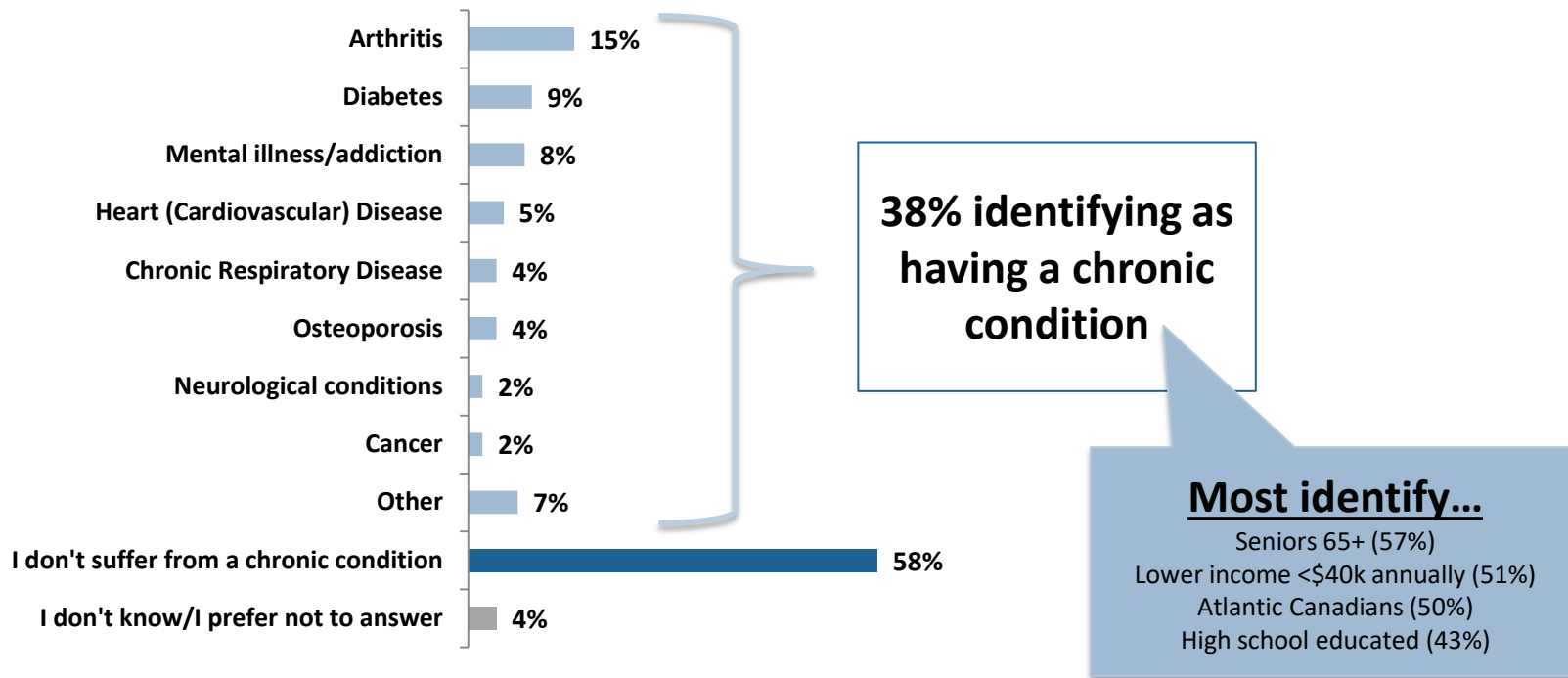

# A sizeable portion of Canadians live with a chronic condition, led by those with arthritis or diabetes

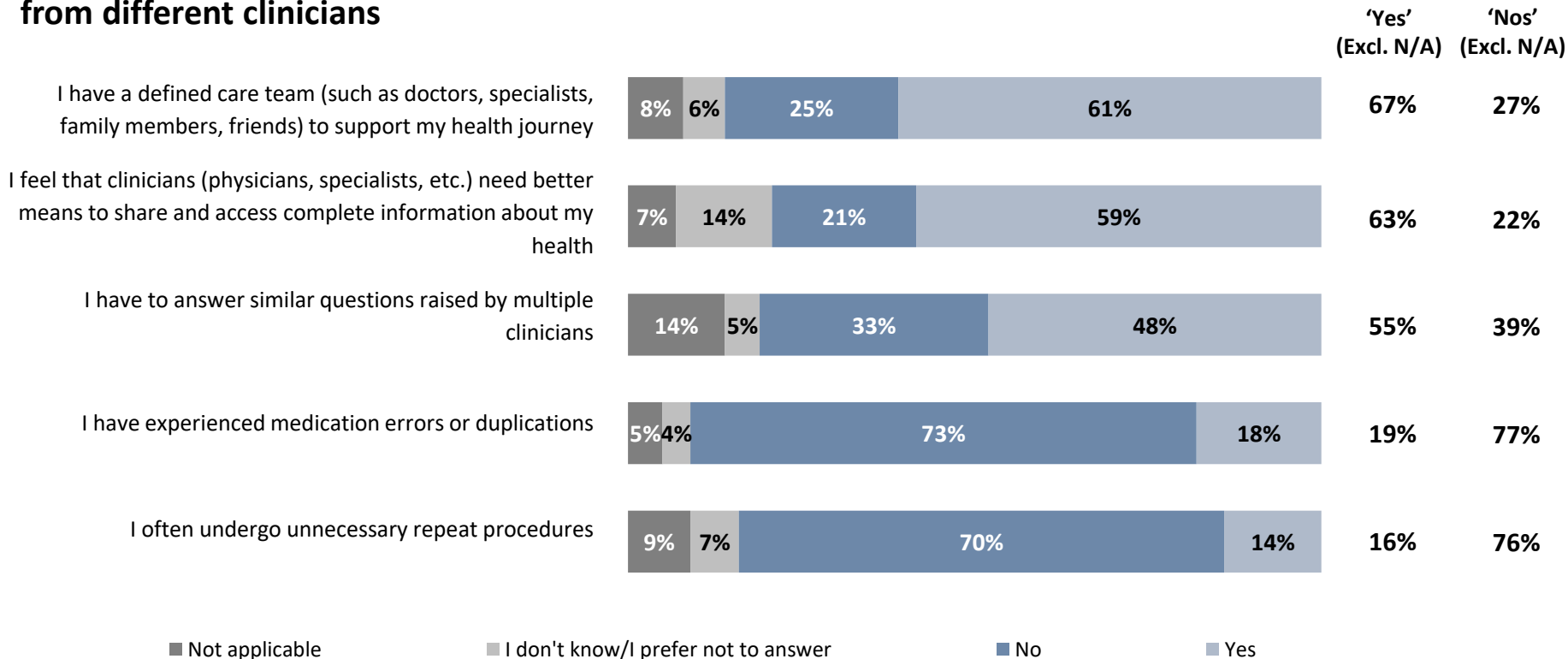


Q1: Do you suffer from any of the following chronic conditions?

# Majority of Canadians with chronic conditions believe that care providers need better means to share information as they have had to answer similar questions from different clinicians

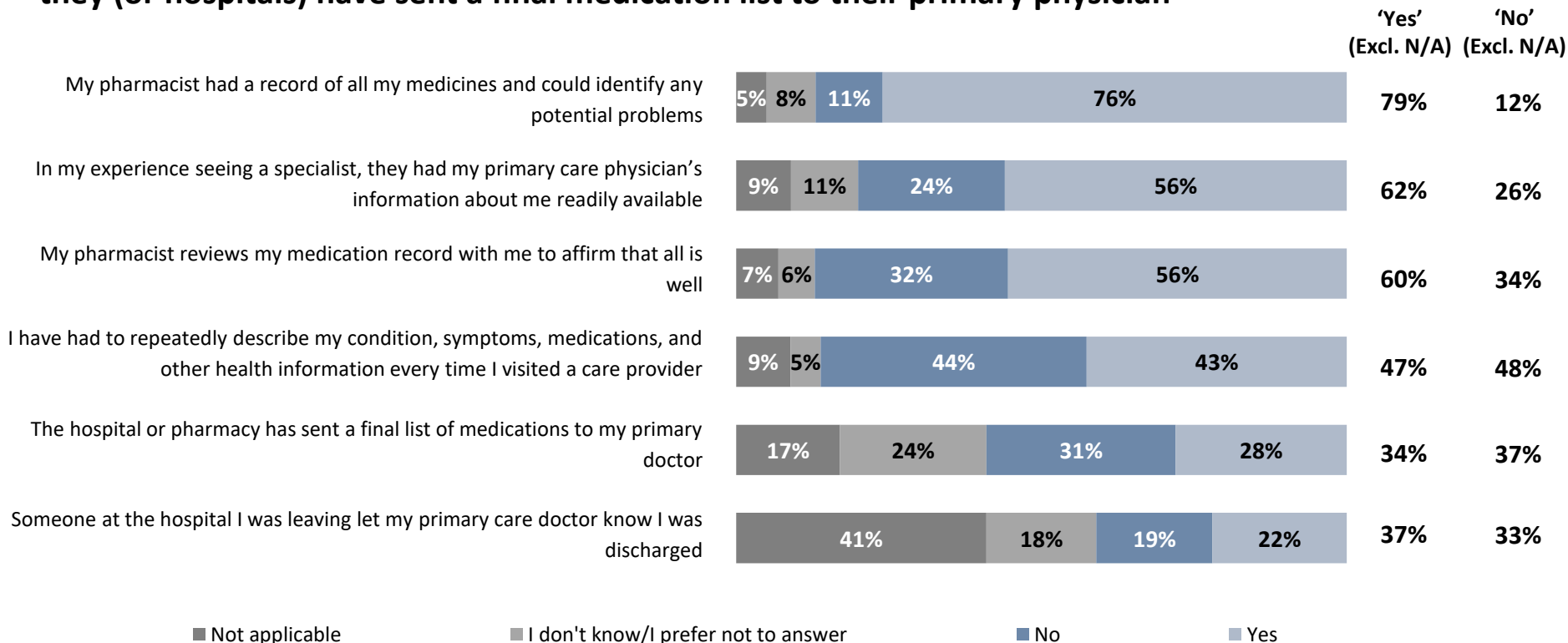


Q2: Please answer 'yes' or 'no' to the following questions?

## A third indicate that their pharmacist reviews their medication with them or that they (or hospitals) have sent a final medication list to their primary physician



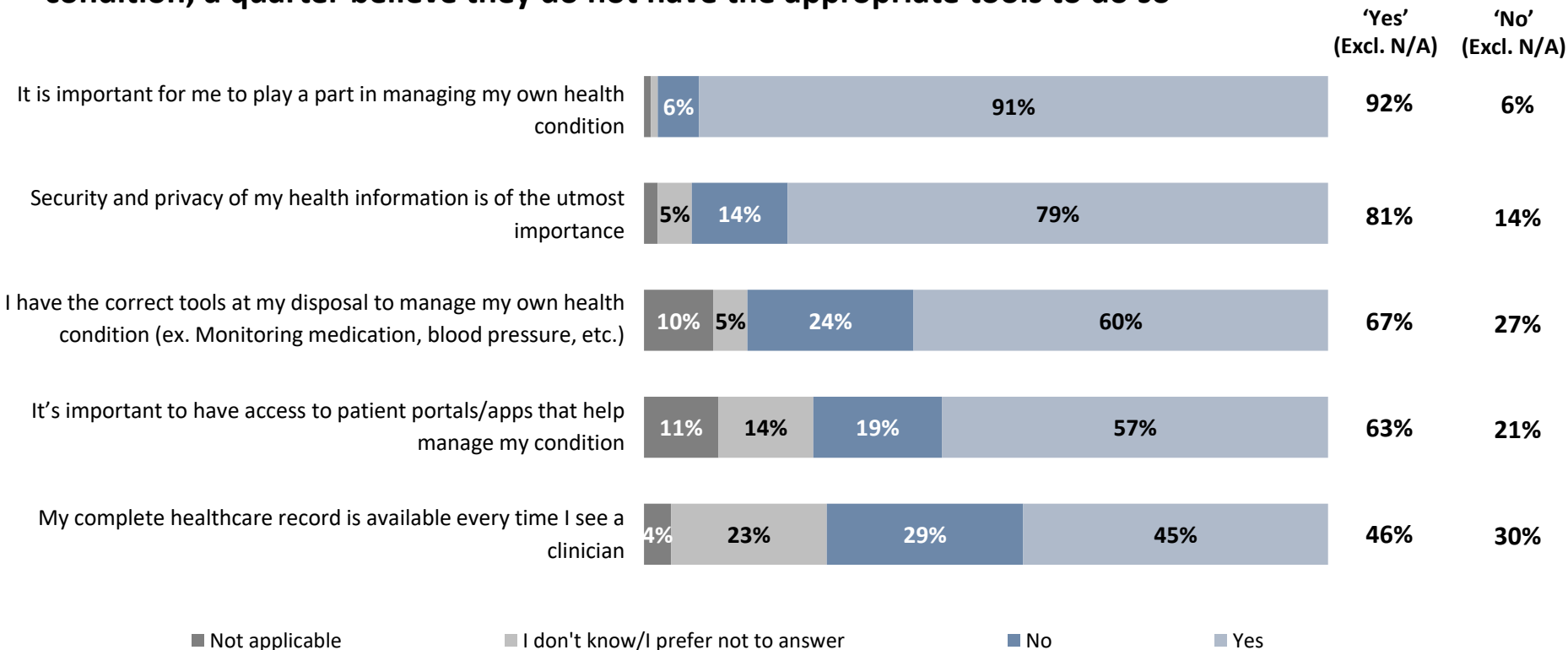

**While nearly all believe that they need to play a part in managing their own condition, a quarter believe they do not have the appropriate tools to do so**



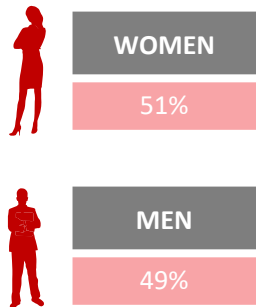

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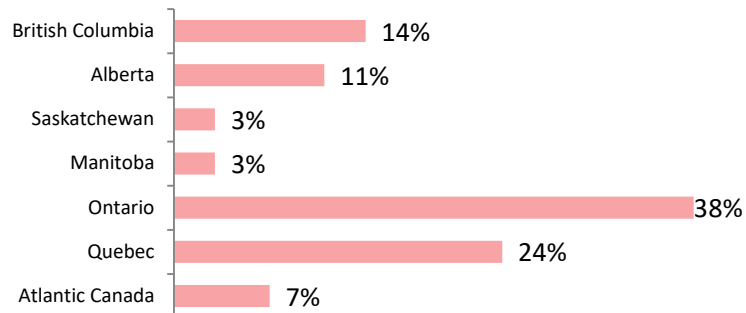

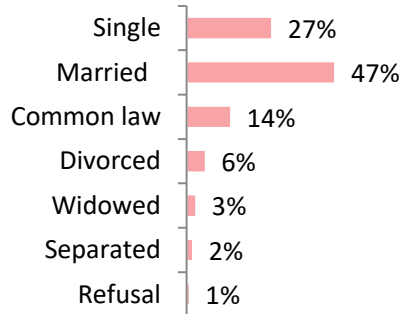

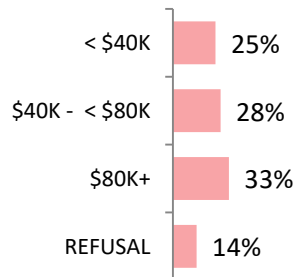

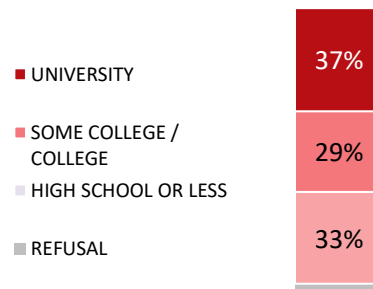
